Mounting Schedule

You are requested to make your first stop at the Poster Counter to make registration before mounting your poster. Poster Counter Opening hours:

Sunday, July 17, 2011	09:00 – 12:45

You are advised to mount your poster on Thursday, July 14, 2011 from 14:00 to 17:00, and dismount on Sunday, July 17, 2011 from 12:45 to 14:00. Please remove your poster no later than Sunday, July 17, 2011 14:00 or it will be discarded.

Poster Registration

All presenting authors of poster presentations are required to register for the Conference and bring with their own poster. Anyone who is unable to attend the Conference must look for replacing author to present the poster.

In case of no suitable author to attend the Conference, a written notification must be sent to the Conference Secretariat at info@bjditan.org before Thursday, June 30, 2011. Anyone who fails to do so will be put on record which will affect future abstract evaluation.

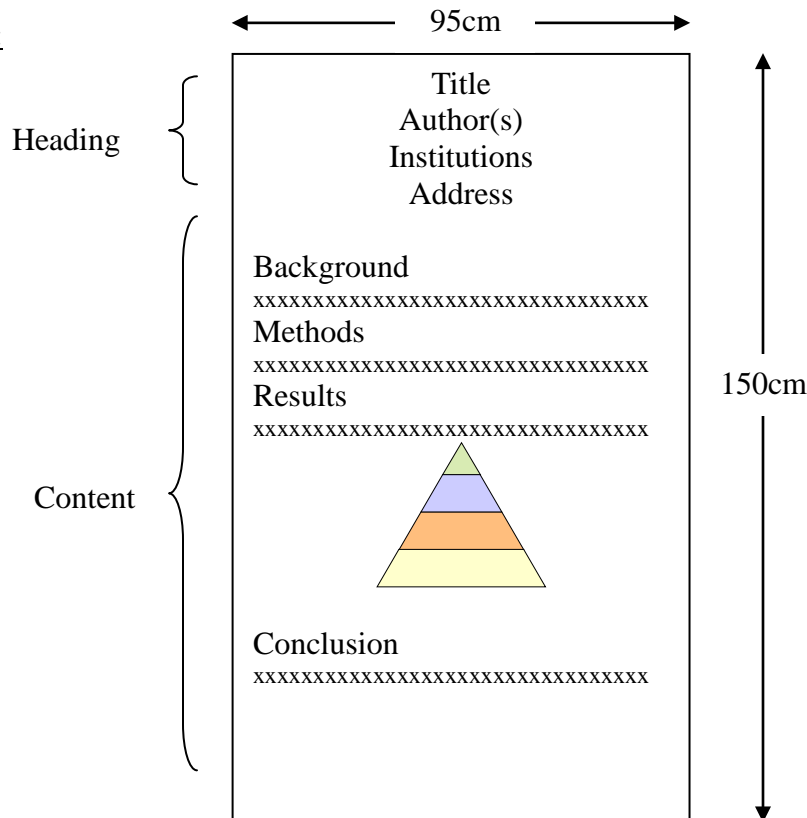

Preparation of Poster

The presenter is strongly advised to discuss his/her research personally with interested scientists using charts, graphs, diagrams and photographs. When preparing your poster, remember that your scientific message must be legible and clearly stated. Follow these simple guidelines for preparing an effective poster:

Dimensions:	Should not exceed 95cm width x 150 cm height (portrait-style)
Language:	English only
Heading:	The heading must be at least a font size of 150 points (1 1/2" or 33mm), indicating the title of the paper, author(s), institution and location, and disclosure information
Text lettering:	Lettering for text and illustrations must be at least a font size of 36 points (3/8" or 10mm)
Depicting Sections:	Each section should be numbered with text in a font size of 150 points (1 1/2" or 33mm) to guide the reader through your poster. Colour is an effective method for separating sections and adding graphic impact. Try to avoid colour combinations that are difficult to read
Premise:	Your poster should include three to five brief sentences outlining information necessary to understand the study, and why it was done. The question(s) to be asked or the hypotheses to be tested should be clearly and succinctly stated
Methods:	Outline your methods briefly, providing only details for new methods, or modifications of older methods
Graphics:	Results presented in the form of a graph or chart are always more effective than blocks of text. Provide a legend for symbols and other details, and interpretation of results below each panel.
Conclusion:	State the conclusion succinctly in large type. (Many viewers read this first, hence, it should be easily understandable.)
Disclosure:	Please provide disclosure information at the bottom of your poster
